INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS FEES

California Education Code Sections 76365, 70902,
81457 and CCR Sections 59400 et seq. and 51012

In accordance with Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations, the San Francisco Community College District has established the following policies regarding instructional materials and fees for instructional materials.

A District Provided Instructional Materials

The District will provide students enrolled in state-supported credit and noncredit courses or programs, without charge, all materials necessary for students to complete those required course objectives which are to be accomplished under the supervision of an instructor during class hours, if such materials are consumed or rendered valueless when used to accomplish these required objectives.

B. Student Provided Materials

The District may require students enrolled in credit or noncredit courses and programs to provide certain instructional and other materials including, but not limited to, textbooks, lab books and workbooks, syllabi or other instructor prepared materials, or tools, equipment, or clothing if:

D. Voluntary Fee

The District may assess a fee for materials which are supplemental or in addition to required materials provided that the payment of such fee is voluntary on the part of the student.
