Pursuant to the requirements of the California Constitution, Governor Gavin Newsom presented his 2023-24 Governor's Budget to the Legislature on Tuesday, January 10th. The next stage of the budget process now begins, with the Legislature discussing, and in some cases, adjusting the funding priorities p

Key Community College Items included in the proposed Governor's Budget
